

INCF Assembly - neuroinformatics.incf.org

The annual INCF Assembly provides a forum for infrastructure providers and developers of tools, standards, and best practices to help define the capabilities of the global network, and receive training on how to participate in the Open, FAIR and Citable global network.

KnowledgeSpace is a community-based, data-driven encyclopedia for neuroscience that links brain research concepts to data, models, and the literature that support them. KS is developed jointly by INCF, The Human Brain Project, and The Neuroscience Information Framework.

Neurostars is a question and answer site that serves the INCF network as a forum for knowledge exchange between national nodes; as a point of interaction between neuroscientists, software developers, and infrastructure providers; and as an integral resource in the network's training and mentoring initiatives.
